Abandoned and Inactive Well Declaration

A well is "abandoned" if it is not used for a period of 1 year unless the owner demonstrates, by meeting the following conditions, an intent to use the well again (Health and Safety Code Section 115700):

1. The well shall not allow impairment of ground water quality.
2. The top of the well shall be sealed to prevent removal of the seal, prevent unauthorized access and illegal disposal and prevent a safety hazard to humans and animals.
3. The well shall be marked to be easily visible and easily identified as a well.
4. The area surrounding the well shall be kept clear of brush, debris, and waste materials.

An "Inactive well" means a water well that has not failed and is not currently being used.

I declare that I intend to use the abandoned or inactive well on **APN** _____

If the well fails or if the required conditions set forth in this declaration form are not maintained I agree to destroy the well in accordance with Glenn County Code and I understand this requirement shall be a condition of all future county permits.
