GLENN COUNTY STABILIZATION GRANT PROGRAM OPPORTUNITY – UP TO \$15,000

GLENN COUNTY – The County of Glenn Board of Supervisors approved the Stabilization Grant Program funded through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 to assist for-profit small business organizations and non-profit organizations with the financial impacts caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The open application period will begin on August 15, 2022 and close at 5:00 P.M. on September 2, 2022. For-profit businesses with less than one hundred (100) employees that are independently owned and operating within Glenn County and non-profits that are 501(c)(3) or 501(c)(19) tax exempt organizations and serve Glenn County residents are eligible to apply. The for-profit program award selection process will be via a lottery, while the non-profit program award selection process will be on a first come-first-serve basis.

The Glenn County Stabilization Grant program will provide a maximum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) in one-time grant awards. These grant funds will assist with the costs associated with the impacts of closures, the costs associated with adherence to local requirements for safe business reopenings, and the financial impacts due to COVID-19.
