US Fish and Wildlife Refuge Representatives -Talks about how he is implementing Secretarial 3356 for more hunting/fishing on refuges- There is now talk of proposed turkey hunting ( in the pheasant only spots) in the Sacramento, Delavan, Sutter, and Colusa Refuges and the also proposed turkey hunting( mentored) in Spring at the Sacramento and Delavan refuges, and in the Fall there will be Sutter, Colusa, ( turkey in the fall-pheasant only spots).
