3) COVID-19 Updates – Butte County

- a. Vaccination clinics
 - 1. Cases in Butte County have gone from over 2200 cases at the peak of Omicron to just over 130 cases, so case rates are down dramatically.
 - 2. Clinics in Butte County are only operating once a week on Thursday's.
- b. Antigen test availability
 - 1. Matt announces that influenza A and B testing along with Binax Now testing is being distributed.
- c. Staffing requests
- d. mAb distribution
 - 1. Glenn county has declined mAb distribution in the past week.
- e. Oral antiviral availability
 - 1. Antivirals are available now throughout Butte County.

4) Healthcare Partner Roundtable - All in attendance. Day to day operations/Current planning activities & best practices/Lessons learned/challenges encountered

- a. Hospital
 - 1. Patti Enloe – participated in exercises with first responders and will soon be participating in the April Chempack drill.
 - a. Enloe will be sending 18 staff members to Alabama for training in the coming months.
 - 2. Rhonda Anderson GMC – GMC and Colusa Medical center had an IT related problem that took their hospital offline recently.
 - a. The problem derived from malware and thankfully, the problem did not escalate.
- b. Local PH Departments
 - 1. Mary Thomas – Glenn County
 - a. There is a decrease in Covid-19 cases in Glenn County.
 - b. Glenn County is withholding putting on future covid clinics, rather, they are providing staffing support for current clinics.
 - c. There is an extreme shortage of nurses in Glenn County.
 - d. HPP – budget finally approved, so covid related trainings are encouraged (reach out to Mary),
 - e. Future trainings are back and listed below.
