2. Update COOP, regardless of it's an emergency or not.

    - 1. Anything out of the ordinary needs to be communicated to MHOAC
    - 2. Please submit resource requests to MHOAC for any shorted items
      - a. The sooner the better and the more precise the better for any resource request.
      - b. Antigen testing allocations have a very specific purpose, meant for uninsured or under insured. Not for places that can easily purchase their own.
  - c. 2022 HCC site visits ongoing (Butte County)
    - 1. Only 1 of 3 hospitals done so far. Matt stressed that this is not a white glove inspection, it's just seeing how items that BCPH has purchased are being used. Not there to get people in trouble.
    - 2. Michele focused on working together and this is about helping everyone help everyone.

    - 1. Goal is to make things easier on the site partner.

### 3) COVID-19 Updates

Cases are increasing, still lower than previous surges.

Current average of 7 days is 42.9 positive.

87.5% of cases in July is Omicron VA.5, rest were Omicron VA2

26 people in hospital, 2 in ICU, 3 deaths since Monday

Confirmed outbreaks in most SNFs

Only investigating in congregate living facilities

- a. Vaccination clinics
  1. Attendance Low. No longer in partner with Enloe. 1 spot in Chico and 1 spot in Oroville.
  2. Feather River Tribal Health test to treat site closing Aug 28<sup>th</sup> due to low volume, Chico state site remaining open.
  3. Orchard Hospital in Gridley still offering vaccines at their clinic M-F
- b. Antigen test availability
  1. Place your orders early due to things ramping up to avoid shortages which might happen again.
- c. Evusheld
  1. Being very under used. Still have at Enloe and Oroville.
- d. mAb distribution
  1. All 3 butte county hospitals have, not being used very often.
  2. Patty Arena noted unused mAb products are still being tracked per State request
- e. Oral antiviral availability
  1. Most every pharmacy has them in Butte County.
    - a. Renal Dosing has been reduced to half for anyone with renal failure.
      - i. Just need a normal RX to obtain.

### 4) Healthcare Partner Roundtable - All in attendance. Day to day operations/Current planning activities & best practices/Lessons learned/challenges encountered

- a. Hospitals
  1. Enloe: 14 COVID-19 Patients. 0 in ICU. 10-15 COVID-19 symptom patients in ED per day. Staffing shortage still presenting problems. Hospital census has remained controlled.
- b. Local PH Departments
  1. Glenn: Down to 1 PH nurse; hiring process underway; hope to have new hires soon.

- a. COVID-19 cases continuing at a steady rate.
- 2. Butte: Nothing additional to report
- c. Clinics
  - 1. Enloe: Active shooter policies are being prepared and made. Active shooter trainings are wanted but local police agencies don't have enough time to help.
- d. Long Term Care Facilities
  - 1. No report
- e. Home Health
  - 1. No report
- f. Organizations Serving People with Access and Functional Needs
  - 1. No report
- g. Any others on the call
  - 1. Patti Carter: Sept 29-30<sup>th</sup> training in Red Bluff "MHOCSA"
    - a. Class will cover Medical and Health Emergency Operations Manual (EOM) concepts. SEMS, and "fab four" EOC positions that support medical and health operations in an EOC/DOC.
    - b. Hospitals region wide are experiencing staffing shortages, state contracts with nurses are ending July 29<sup>th</sup>.
    - c. "Big 5" hospitals in Region III are experiencing longer wait times in ED due to short staffing.
